- Show **respect** for yourself and others
 - be helpful to others
 - be mindful of surroundings
 - people
 - situations
 - supplies
 - furniture
 - the environment
- Act with **integrity**
 - be responsible
 - productively lead or influence others
 - be truthful
- Be **accountable**
 - complete assignments on time
 - have daily materials
- Be **cooperative** and **dependable**
 - listen to and follow directions
 - be prepared and on-task
 - be reliable—follow through on commitments
 - be supportive of others
- Do your **personal best**
 - participate positively in class activities and discussions
 - put forth an honest effort
 - stretch your skills

Ways to Negatively Impact Conduct Grades

- Not following RMS and Team Aloha rules
- Show a lack of respect for yourself and others
 - distract self or others
 - not mindful of materials
 - offend others
- Act with a lack of integrity
 - be irresponsible
 - negatively lead or influence others
- Be less than fully accountable
 - have 5 or more assignments late/incomplete/missing every 9 weeks
 - lack daily materials
 - go to your locker during class time
- Be un-cooperative and undependable
 - do not listen to and follow directions
 - be unprepared or off-task
- Do less than your personal best
 - participate negatively or not at all in class activities and discussions
 - put forth little effort
 - avoid or refuse to try/exercise new skills
